## 5 easy steps to get connected

- 1 Check if there's natural gas in your street**  
Call 0508 GAS HUB (427 482) and we'll let you know.
- 2 Choose your gas retailer**  
Set up an account with a natural gas retailer. Not sure who that is? We can point you in the right direction.
- 3 Apply with us**  
Submit your application at [thegashub.co.nz](https://thegashub.co.nz) or call us to apply.
- 4 Accept the connection agreement**  
Once you've signed it, we'll get the connection process started.
- 5 Get ready for your connection**  
We'll let you know the date of connection, so you can let your gasfitter know when they can install your appliances.
